Before you start, please have the following ready: (1) your organization's EIN, (2) your organization's Claude.ai (Team/Enterprise) and/or Claude Console Organization ID(s) (find in Admin Settings), (3) name, title, and email for your leadership sponsor, fellow supervisor, and authorized signer, (4) a sense of the types of projects you'd want a fellow to work on (it's OK if they're not fully scoped).

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis in the first year of the program, with start dates in October 2026, January 2027, and August 2027. However, organizations interested in hosting a fellow for the October 2026 cohort must submit their applications by 11:59 pm PT on **Friday, July 17, 2026**. The first cohort begins **Monday, October 19, 2026**.
